Important Benefits Announcement— OneUSG Alert for Retirees

The purpose of this article is to alert you of a change that is taking place this summer with the way University System of Georgia retirees pay for optional USG benefits. If you have optional USG retiree dental, vision, supplemental life insurance, or pre-65 healthcare coverage, this change will affect you.

You should have already received a letter from the University System explaining these changes. If you have not received such a letter you may obtain a copy by calling University of West Georgia's Human Resources Department at 678-839-6403.

Beginning on June 26, 2017, the University System of Georgia is initiating two new ways to access your optional USG retiree benefits: a OneUSG Benefits website and a OneUSG Benefits call center. Between June 26 and July 9 you will need to use either the OneUSG website or call center to provide banking information to arrange payment for your premiums for optional USG benefits. If you do not take the required action during this time period, you will receive a bill via regular mail for 1-2 months. After this, however, if you don't provide the information required to either the website or the call center, you are at risk of losing your vision, dental, supplemental life insurance, or pre-65 healthcare benefit(s). No benefits will be lost if you provide the required information.

Note that the changes listed above do not replace the Aon website and call center, which you will continue to use for health insurance and prescription drug insurance. Note also that your benefits and premiums are not changing.

Human Resources will hold an open meeting about this new process on Thursday, June 8, from 10 am to 11 am, in the lower level of Z6. On Tuesday, June 27 and on June 28, from 9 am to 4 pm, Human Resources will staff a computer lab in the Coliseum where retirees may access the OneUSG website to enter their banking information (retirees will need to bring their banking information with them). All retirees are welcome to attend these events.
