Graduate Revise Program Requestion

Rationale: The original structure of the MS in Strategic Cybersecurity and
Information Management requires 10 courses plus one pre-requisite. There are no
electives. The program does not offer flexibility for students or allow for a Spring or
Summer start. We are proposing the following changes to remove barriers to entry and
make the program more accessible to students who do not have a technology-related
degree. 1. Remove 5500 and 5600 from the core and replace these two core classes with
Electives. This will create a program with 8 core classes and 2 electives. 2. Promote

5500
and 5600 as electives to students who want to complete the CISCO certifications.

They
must complete one undergraduate prerequisite (CISM 4333), start the

program in the fall, and take 5500 and 5600 for their electives. 3. Remove the "technology-related degree" requirement for admission. We hope these changes will remove barriers to entry and provide much-needed flexibility in the program.
