



UWG 2025 HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

According to the Board of Regents policy, each institution within the University System of Georgia is allowed thirteen (13) paid holidays per calendar year for employees. After consulting the academic calendar, the President’s Cabinet has adopted the following 2025 Official Holiday Schedule for the University of West Georgia.

*Reduced Services: UWG employees should consult with their immediate supervisor and appropriate division/college leadership to determine necessary staffing for their area.

All regular, benefited employees working full-time or part-time (20 hours or more per week) will be paid for the holidays. Non-exempt and/or essential employees scheduled to work on a holiday will receive 8 hours of holiday pay plus pay for actual hours worked.
