Purpose/Reason for Policy

The University of West Georgia (UWG) shall comply with all applicable environmental laws and regulations and employ best practices to minimize the environmental impact of its operations.

This policy and associated procedures set UWG's expectations in the area of environmental compliance toward the goal of protecting the environment, ensuring effective operations, and satisfying federal, state, and local regulations

This policy outlines a consistent and comprehensive approach to risk management at the University of West Georgia (UWG). It ensures that all members of the university community actively engage in identifying, assessing, and managing risks through the Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) framework, helping to achieve UWG's strategic goals while minimizing any potential adverse effects.

Policy Statement

This policy applies to all faculty, staff, and administrators, emphasizing the integration of risk management into day-to-day planning and decision-making processes. University community leaders and members are expected to adhere to this policy and proactively manage risks to ensure the institution's long-term success and resilience.

The University is committed to environmental stewardship in its proactively managing risks to ensure long-term success in it's operations and practices. This commitment is demonstrated through the following:

- Meeting or exceeding applicable environmental laws, regulatory mandates, and best practices,
- · Establishing procedures and standards in environmental risk reporting and accountability,
- · Setting measurable objectives to reduce the University's environmental impact,

- · Pursuing environmentally-sustainable objectives, and,
- · Communicating the institution's responsibilities and successes through all levels of leadership.
