**Title:** Addressing the needs of uninsured adults in Oklahoma City: A pilot study of an e-Health Promotion Program

**Description:** Study an enhanced, web-based health risk assessment (HRA) that was implemented successfully in primary care and in faith-based community settings, coupled with personalized, goal-directed health planning and facilitated by health coaching. Partnering with the Health Alliance for the Uninsured [HAU], one free/charitable clinic was selected for this pilot study.
